- All students who are registered for **Aftercare** will receive:

 - Additionally, Aftercare students will have the opportunity to sign up for three activities
 - As is customary, if you are in school and not in Aftercare or have an activity you will be charged a **\$30 drop-in fee**.

Saint Augustine Afterschool Activity Program

- Saint Augustine Catholic School provides **two (2) Afterschool** activities for \$350 which you paid during your child(ren)'s enrollment.
- There are 24 **Afterschool** activities for Saint Augustine students to choose.
- Afterschool Activities begin on Tuesday, October 11, 2022.
- At the conclusion of your child(ren)'s activity they are not picked up immediately there will be a \$30 drop-in fee.
- Students who are not in Aftercare or have an activity must be picked up by 3:45 pm or they will be placed in Aftercare and assessed a \$30 drop-in fee.
- Students with Activities starting at 4:00 pm are allowed to wait in aftercare without a charge.
- Students whose activities begin after 4:30 will be charged a reduced drip in fee of \$15.
- Occasionally there may be an emergency or event that will necessitate the cancellation of Aftercare. Saint Augustine will notify of any cancellation.
- We are interested in running several additional activities however volunteers are needed: ballet; cooking; chess; debate; double dutch; drama; model UN and tap.

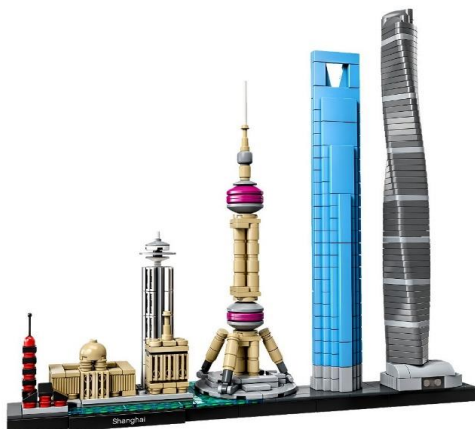

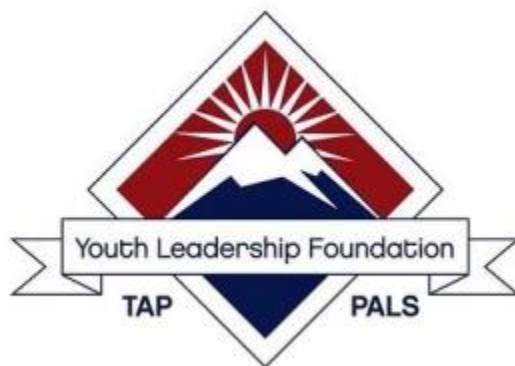

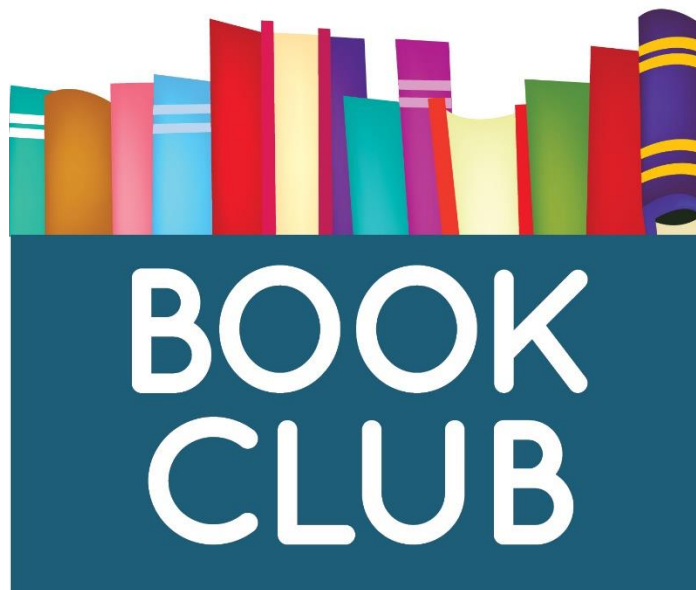

MANDATORY CHILD PROTECTION POLICY PROCEDURES FOR VOLUNTEERING WITH CHILDREN AND YOUTH

FIRST STEPS:

REGISTER FOR THE CHILD PROTECTION TRAINING BY...

1. Going to www.virtus.org and click the button for "First-Time Registrant" and follow the prompts to register for the "Washington DC" Archdiocese.
2. Once registered, select a training location most convenient for you to attend.
3. Attend the training and pick up your Certificate of Completion and Policy Acknowledgment Sheet at the end of the training.
4. Bring a copy of your Certificate and Policy Acknowledgment Sheet to the church office.

SECOND STEP:

COMPLETE THE VOLUNTEER APPLICATION & FINGERPRINTING

THIRD STEP:

Go for **fingerprinting at the most convenient location** near you. Available locations are listed online. Cost for fingerprinting varies from location to location. Once your fingerprinting is completed, the Archdiocese will inform the church office of the results.
