Gospel In the Park – November 18th

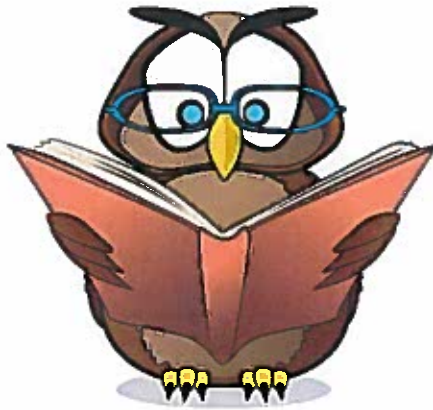
