**REPORT CARDS:** Report Cards were issued last Friday. There were quite a few errors involving the attendance codes. The errors have been fixed, and you can go into the Rediker system to view your child's grades and attendance. If you do not have access to the Redkier system, please see or contact Mr. Wilkins in the main office to get you set up. If there are any concerns about attendance, or grades you can contact Mrs. Woods, so that you can schedule an appointment with the assigned teacher, and Mrs. Woods will take care of the attendance issues.

**SPRING FLING:** All parents are welcome to come to the Spring Fling on Friday, April 20, 2018. Concession stands will be available for items to be sold. Also there will be NO aftercare or afterschool activities that evening. Grades Pre-K through Second Grade dance is from 2:15 - 3:30 pm. Please make sure all students are picked up promptly at the conclusion of your child's dance. In addition, no one is allowed to wait along the stairs of the front entrance during pick up. We notice that parents are opening the main door for others to come into the school. We must continue to keep our students, and staff safe at all times. The door is only to be opened between the hours of 7:30-4:30pm. After-school staff will then open the door from 4:30-6:00pm. No one will be allowed to enter the school and freely roam the halls at any time.

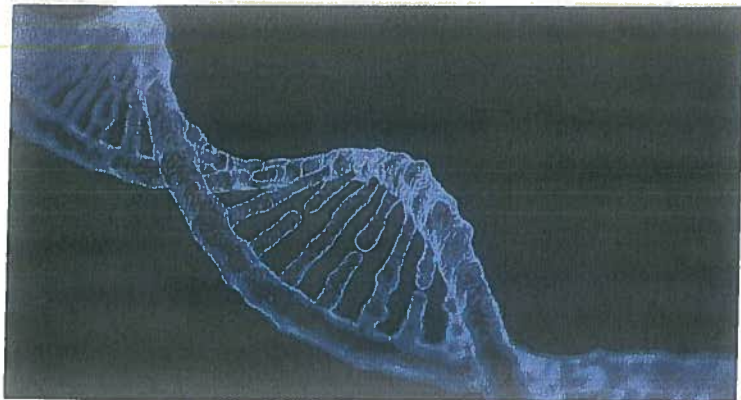
